Improving our governance

COVID-19 has challenged our Board in a number of ways, but we are continuing to work together to improve the governance and accountability of MDAS, while strengthening important relationships. Key pieces of work include:

- Auditing our Confirmation of Aboriginality process: This involves going
 through previous approvals and rejections to ensure the appropriate process was
 followed and the decisions were correct. There is a lot of work involved in this and
 it is likely to take until the end of October to complete. It's important work and
 means you Mob can be confident the right decisions are being made now and
 into the future.
- Undertaking policy reviews: A detailed review of MDAS policies is underway to address gaps and ensure we have robust processes in place. The Conflict of Interest Policy and Financial Delegations Policy are among those we are looking at, both of which are required to ensure we are delivering good governance of the organisation.
- Maintaining strong relationships: The Board was recently briefed on the
 relationship MDAS has with its largest funder, the Victorian Department of
 Families, Fairness and Housing. This relationship continues to be strong and
 MDAS remains focused on delivering against important contracts and action
 plans we have in place with the department.
